ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to two-player teams with a parent-child relationship. Partners may have more than one generation between them, (i.e., a grandfather may play with his grandson or granddaughter). Relationship with the child may be natural, adopted, or stepchild. Both partners must have an active GHIN number and Handicap Index issued by a WSGA member club not exceeding 36.4 for males or 40.4 for females, at the time of entry.

ENTRIES

Teams may apply via the WSGA website at www.thewsga.org. Credit cards will be charged at the time of entry. Teams may also apply on a WSGA entry form obtainable from the WSGA office or downloadable from the WSGA website. **Team members must register together.** An entry fee of \$165 shall be paid by each team, except for the defending champions.

Entries, along with the appropriate fee, must be received by the WSGA by 4:30 p.m. on July 2, 2018. Refunds due to cancellation on or before July 2, 2018 are subject to a \$10 service charge. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED AFTER JULY 2, 2018.**

Late entries will be accepted and placed on an alternate's list to fill spots if they become available up until a time that the WSGA Staff establishes. Late entries will not be accepted unless they are accompanied by the correct entry fee, plus an additional administrative fee of \$25. Contestants must contact the WSGA in order to submit a late entry.

CONDITIONS

The WSGA Championship Committee reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The Committee reserves the right to reject the entry of any applicant, at any time, for any reason. Any decision by the Committee, in any matter, shall be final.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Unacceptable conduct or behavior on the golf course or anywhere on club property will not be tolerated and are grounds for immediate disqualification, at any time, from any WSGA Championship. **The WSGA definition of unacceptable conduct or behavior will be provided at the championship.**

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

In all WSGA Championships, a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play, (e.g., elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14.3.

CARTS/CADDIES

The use of automotive carts during championship play is permitted. Teams who wish to reserve a cart, may do so through the golf shop at the event. Since this is a team competition, only one cart per team is permitted. Contestants who wish to reserve a cart should indicate so on the entry form. Caddies are permitted. Host club caddies will not be available.

DRESS CODE

The WSGA expects all contestants and their caddies to wear suitable attire on the host club property throughout the duration of the championship, including practice rounds. The full WSGA Dress Code Policy can be found online at www.thewsga.org and will be provided to all players, along with any additional measures required by the host club, after the entry deadline. Gallery must adhere to the host club dress code policy. Failure to adhere to the dress code may result in disqualification and removal from the course.

CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE

18-hole Chapman stroke play competition (gross and net). The field will be divided into flights based on team course handicap. Team handicap will be determined by combining 60% of the low course handicap and 40% of the high course handicap. Males and females will play from a separate set of tees. Ties for the overall gross champions will be decided by a sudden-death playoff immediately following the conclusion of the final round.

WITHDRAWAL POLICY

Refunds are not available after the closing deadline except for documented and approved medical reasons. All refunds are subject to a \$25 service fee.

During play of the championship, a "Withdrawal Form", available from a WSGA staff member, must be completed by any competitor withdrawing. Entrants who unofficially withdraw, by not filling out a form or without sufficient reason, may not be granted entry into any future WSGA championship for a minimum of two years.

LODGING

The WSGA recommends that contestants make their lodging arrangements at the earliest possible date. The WSGA provides highly discounted rates of up to 70% on hotels as a part of the "WSGA Rewards" program. Contestants can access hotel bookings in close proximity to the golf course using their GHIN number online at www.thewsga.org.

CHAMPIONSHIP EXEMPTIONS

A place in the field will be reserved for the **2017 Parent-Child Champions, Jason Aspelund and Mark Aspelund**, until July 2, 2018. **Note: The team must be made up of the same players in order to receive the exemption.** All entries submitted after this date will be accepted in the order received (*Exempt players must meet the eligibility and handicap requirements of this championship*).
