ELIGIBILITY

Entries are open to amateur golfers who are female and who: a) are members in good standing of a WSGA member club; b) are 50 years of age or older for the Senior Amateur and 65 years of age or older for the Super Senior Amateur by June 26, 2018; and c) have an active GHIN number and USGA Handicap Index, issued by a WSGA member club, not exceeding 40.4 at the time of entry. The field limit is 24 for the Senior Women's Amateur and 24 for the Super Senior Women's Amateur. Since the championships will run concurrently, the WSGA reserves the right to increase either field limit to reach a full field of 48.

ENTRIES

Entrants may apply via the WSGA website at www.thewsga.org. Credit cards will be charged at the time of entry. Entrants may also apply on a WSGA entry form obtainable from the WSGA office or downloadable from the WSGA website. An entry fee of \$165 shall be paid by each player, except for the defending champions.

Entries, along with the appropriate fee, must be received by 4:30 p.m., on June 11, 2018. Refunds due to cancellation on or before June 11, 2018 are subject to a \$10 service charge. **NO REFUNDS WILL BE ISSUED AFTER JUNE 11, 2018.**

Late entries will be accepted and placed on an alternate's list to fill spots if they become available up until a time that the WSGA Staff establishes. Late entries will not be accepted unless they are accompanied by the correct entry fee, plus an additional administrative fee of \$25. Contestants must contact the WSGA in order to submit a late entry.

CONDITIONS

The WSGA Championship Committee reserves the right to alter any of the conditions and schedules herein. The Committee reserves the right to reject the entry of any applicant, at any time, for any reason. Any decision by the Committee, in any matter, shall be final.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Unacceptable conduct or behavior on the golf course or on club property will not be tolerated and are grounds for immediate disqualification, at any time, from any WSGA Championship. **The WSGA definition of unacceptable conduct or behavior will be provided at the championship.**

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES

In all WSGA Championships, a player may obtain distance information by use of a distance-measuring device. If, during a stipulated round, a player uses a distance-measuring device to gauge or measure other conditions that might affect her play, (e.g., elevation changes, wind speed, etc.), the player is in breach of Rule 14.3.

CARTS/CADDIES

The use of automotive carts during championship play is permitted. Contestants who wish to reserve a cart must indicate so on the entry form. Cart fees are \$15 per rider, per round and must be remitted along with the entry fee. No outside, private carts will be permitted during the championship. Contestants may have a caddie. Host club caddies will not be available.

DRESS CODE

The WSGA expects all contestants and their caddies to wear suitable attire on the host club property throughout the duration of the championship, including practice rounds. The full WSGA Dress Code Policy can be found online at www.thewsga.org and will be provided to all players, along with any additional measures required by the host club, after the entry deadline. Gallery must adhere to the host club dress code policy. Failure to adhere to the dress code may result in disqualification and removal from the course.

PRACTICE ROUND

All contestants will be allowed one complimentary practice round prior to the championship. Consideration will be made for out-of-town players with regard to reserved starting times the day prior to the championship. Contestants can reserve practice round times directly through the golf shop. All practice round times are at the discretion of the golf shop staff.

CHAMPIONSHIP SCHEDULE

36-hole stroke play competition (gross and net). The Senior Women's Amateur and Super Senior Women's Amateur Championships will be run concurrently. Each championship will play from a separate sets of tees. In the event of a tie for the gross champion, in either championship, a sudden-death playoff will be used to determine the champion immediately following the conclusion of the final round.

WITHDRAWAL POLICY

Refunds are not available after the closing deadline except for documented and approved medical reasons. All refunds are subject to a \$25 service fee.

During play of the championship, a "Withdrawal Form", available from a WSGA staff member, must be completed by any competitor withdrawing. Entrants who unofficially withdraw, by not filling out a form or without sufficient reason, may not be granted entry into any future WSGA championship for a minimum of two years.

LODGING

The WSGA recommends that contestants make their lodging arrangements at the earliest possible date. The WSGA provides highly discounted rates of up to 70% on hotels as a part of the "WSGA Rewards" program. Contestants can access hotel bookings in close proximity to the golf course using their GHIN number online at www.thewsga.org.
